History: Diagnosed with cardiac disease after a very slow recovery from anesthesia. Had fluid in chest at that time. Started on furosemide, enalapril, and a vitamin mix. Current radiographs show possible mild cardiomegaly, clear lungs. Added pimobendane to therapy. Echo pending.

**ELECTROCARDIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

A single lead ECG is submitted for review.

Normal sinus rhythm is present throughout this recording. All complex amplitudes and intervals are within normal limits. No premature beats or conduction blocks are seen.

**ASSESSMENT/RECOMMENDATIONS**

Boo Radley's ECG demonstrates no abnormalities. Having said that, ECGs are insensitive indicators of cardiac chamber enlargement and do not evaluate cardiac function, therefore, the absence of abnormalities in an ECG does not rule out the presence of structural heart disease.
