Foxy Decker

History: Grade II murmur. Coughing. Echo pending. Receiving furosemide 6.25 mg BID.

SPECIES

Canine

ELECTROCARDIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

A single lead ECG is submitted for review.

BREED

Chinese Crested

HR: 130 bpm
Rhythm: Sinus

Normal sinus rhythm and sinus arrhythmia are present in this recording. All complex amplitudes and intervals are within normal limits. No premature beats or conduction blocks are seen.

ASSESSMENT/RECOMMENDATIONS

Foxy's ECG demonstrates no abnormalities. Having said that, ECGs are Insensitive Indicators of cardiac chamber enlargement and do not evaluate cardiac function, therefore, it's unclear whether Foxy's murmur could be due to the presence of relevant cardiac disease based on her ECG alone.

AGE

4 years

In addition to the pending echocardiogram, thoracic radiographs may be warranted to further evaluate Foxy's cough.

WEIGHT

No therapy is recommended based on this recording.

A recheck ECG is recommended if new physical exam and/or clinical abnormalities suggestive of the presence of an arrhythmia develop.
