History: Grade II murmur. Pre-anesthetic evaluation. Echo pending.

SPECIES ELECTROCARDIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Canine

A single lead ECG is submitted for review.

HR: 119 bpm
Rhythm: Sinus arrhythmia

BREED

Dachshund

Sinus arrhythmia is present throughout this recording. All complex amplitudes and intervals are within normal limits. No premature beats or conduction blocks are seen.

SEX ASSESSMENT/RECOMMENDATIONS

FS

Lily's ECG demonstrates no abnormalities. Sinus arrhythmia is a normal finding in dogs and is associated with elevated vagal tone. Typically, dogs with cardiac disease that have sinus arrhythmia have well-compensated disease, though Lily's echocardiogram will give a better idea of the severity of any structural heart disease that may be present.

AGE

11 years

There are no contraindications to general anesthesia based on Lily's ECG.

WEIGHT

22.5#

No therapy is recommended based on this recording.

A recheck ECG is recommended if new physical exam and/or clinical abnormalities suggestive of the presence of an arrhythmia develop.
