ELECTROCARDIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

A single lead ECG is submitted for review.

Normal sinus rhythm and sinus arrhythmia are present in this recording. All complex amplitudes and intervals are within normal limits. No premature beats or conduction blocks are seen.

ASSESSMENT/RECOMMENDATIONS

Dixie's ECG demonstrates no abnormalities. Having said that, ECGs are insensitive indicators of cardiac chamber enlargement and do not evaluate cardiac function, therefore, the absence of abnormalities in an ECG does not rule out the presence of structural heart disease, especially considering the presence of a heart murmur.

PATIENT

No therapy is recommended based on Dixie's ECG. There are no contraindications to anesthesia based on Dixie's ECG, however, there could be based on the results of echocardiography, if performed.

SPECIES

Canine

A recheck ECG is recommended if new physical exam and/or clinical abnormalities suggestive of the presence of an arrhythmia develop.
