HOLTER MONITOR FINDINGS AND RHYTHM ASSESSMENT

Interpretation: Underlying normal sinus rhythm with presumably appropriate rate variation. Occasional pauses while sleeping. Max HR appears sinus in origin. No ectopy, extended pauses, AV block or other dysrhythmias appreciated.

RECOMMENDATIONS

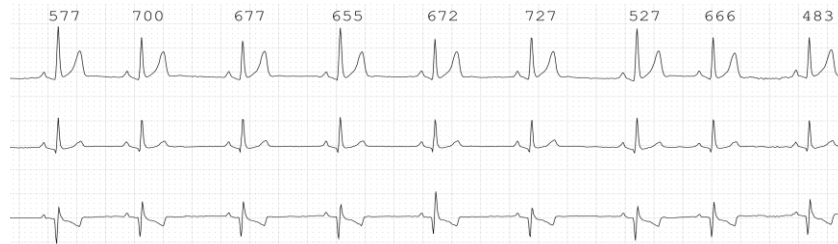
Apparently normal recording. No significant pauses are noted, and no malignant arrhythmias identified. The max HR appears sinus in origin, without obvious SVT or VT.

No cause for collapse is seen here. Highly recommended an echocardiogram given HW positive status, as this may be a related issue (ie PAH). If the patient continues to experience collapse episodes without a clear cause, consider use of a mobile device such as an AliveCor (kardia) or implantation of an event monitor. That being said, suspicion is low in this case and other possibilities should be considered such as a musculoskeletal abnormality, BP swings, etc.

No medications are indicated at this time.
