Interpretation: Underlying normal sinus rhythm with appropriate rate variation. No ectopy, extended pauses, AV block or other dysrhythmias appreciated.

AGE

8 years

RECOMMENDATIONS

Apparently normal recording. No significant pauses are noted, and no malignant arrhythmias identified. The max HR appears sinus in origin, without obvious SVT or VT.

WEIGHT

9 lbs

If the patient continues to experience collapse episodes without a clear cause, consider use of a mobile device such as an AliveCor (kardia) or implantation of an event monitor. That being said, suspicion is low in this case and other possibilities should be considered such as structural cardiac disease, systemic illness, etc. An echocardiogram could be considered pending further systemic work up (lab work, etc).
