**ELECTROCARDIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

A six lead ECG is available at both 25 and 50mm/s; 5mm/mV. The average heart rate is 120bpm (range 100-150bpm). The rhythm is sinus in origin, with a p for every QRS complex and vice versa. The P wave morphology is positive with a normal dimension. Normal PR. The QRS morphology is positive with normal dimension. MEA is normal. No ectopic beats, pauses or other dysrhythmias observed.

ECG diagnosis: Normal sinus rhythm with respiratory variation.

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

Normal ECG with no evidence of dysrhythmias. If arrhythmias are suspected or heard on exam, a holter monitor may be indicated in this predisposed breed. Presence of a chronic murmur warrants further evaluation and an echocardiogram is recommended.

No treatment is indicated.
