**DATE** History: Grade 2/6 murmur, suspect gallop sound.

10/26/22 **ELECTROCARDIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**  
A three lead ECG is submitted for review.

**PERFORMED BY:** HR: 150 bpm  
Rhythm: Sinus

**INTERPRETED BY** Normal sinus rhythm/mild sinus tachycardia is present throughout this recording. The MEA is normal. All complex amplitudes and intervals are within normal limits. No premature beats or conduction blocks are seen.

**ASSESSMENT/RECOMMENDATIONS**  
Normal ECG

**PATIENT** Jet's ECG demonstrates no abnormalities. Given her breed and age, it's likely that her murmur and suspect gallop sound are due to the presence of degenerative mitral valve disease, and echocardiogram and/or thoracic radiography is recommended for further evaluation.
