OBSERVATIONS

Lymph node: Submitted is a single video of cells collected from the lymph node in Layla. The cellularity is moderate throughout the video. There are lymphoid cells with many of the cells small to intermediate. Scattered reactive cells are present interspersed with neutrophils and macrophages. The lymphoid cells do not demonstrate characteristic malignant patterns. The cellularity is reactive.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Lymph node - Reactive lymphoid tissue with chronic suppurative lymphadenitis.

SPECIES

COMMENTS

The cellularity in this collection includes lymphoid cells that are reactive to some type of an antigenic process. Neutrophils are present and there are scattered macrophages. The cellularity again is supporting reactive lymphoid tissue. I am unable to identify neoplasia. Some of the lymphoid cells are reactive and have a larger pattern but many are small to slightly intermediate. The itching easily could be allergy with some inflammation draining to these lymph nodes. This could also be some type of systemic process including atopy or food allergy that is affecting the lymph nodes and the skin. Continued evaluation for a potential of an allergic process is encouraged.

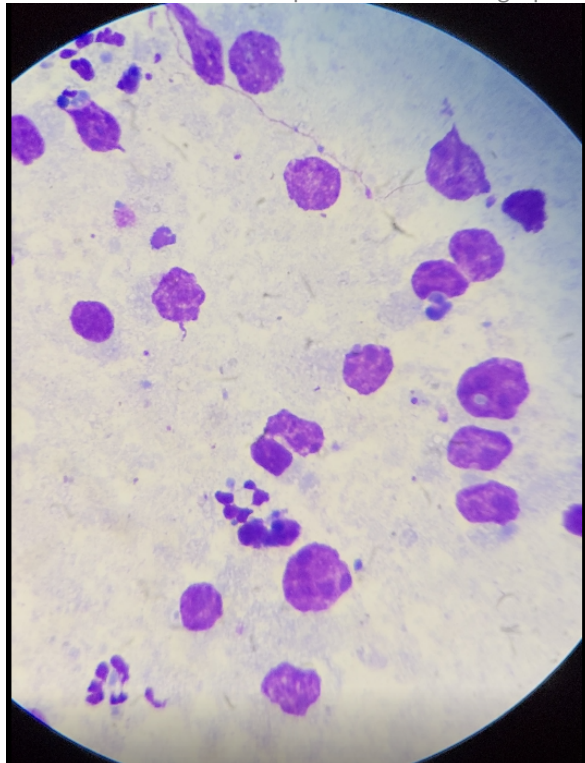


Image shows a representative collection of cells from the lymph node in Layla. Note the neutrophils and reactive lymphocytes.
