History: Grade 3/6 murmur. LAFB seen in pre-anesthetic ECG.

ECHOCARDIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

2D, M-mode, and Doppler study.

Left atrial size is normal. The mitral valve appears normal. Left ventricular wall thickness is normal. Left ventricular internal dimensions are normal. Left ventricular systolic function is hyperdynamic. The aorta and aortic valve appear normal. Right atrial and right ventricular dimensions are normal. The tricuspid valve appears normal. The pulmonary artery and pulmonic valve appear normal. No shunting lesions are visualized. No pericardial effusion or cardiac masses are seen.

This examination demonstrates no obvious evidence of structural heart disease. As such, the LAFB seen in Shadow's ECG appears to be a normal variant. While a definitive reason for Shadow's murmur was not visualized in this exam, it's likely that his murmur is functional/innocent in nature.

BREED

DSH

Shadow's cardiovascular risk for general anesthesia is low based on this exam, and there are no contraindications to the use of any specific anesthetic agents.

SEX

No cardiac therapy is recommended based on this exam.

AGE

A recheck echocardiogram is recommended if the characteristics of Shadow's murmur change, or if other new physical exam and/or clinical abnormalities suggestive of the presence of cardiac dysfunction develop.
