The cat was presented three days ago with the complain of rapid breathing. In addition, the cat is having generalized edema. There is swelling under the tongue due to ranula which was marsupialised in another clinic recently. As per the owner the cat is eating normal at home. Hematocrit 22.80 (24-45) The rest of the hematology and biochemistry are within the normal range.

PATIENT OBSERVATIONS

Pleural fluid: The images show minimal numbers of cells. The majority of the cells are RBCs. There are scattered neutrophils, eosinophils and probably lymphocytes. The fluid is minimally cellular. There is no suggestion of neoplasia or sepsis.

SPECIES INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Feline

Pleural fluid: Minimally cellular fluid suggesting potential cardiovascular problems or with the eosinophils, consider allergy or parasites.

BREED

Domestic Shorthair

COMMENTS

The eosinophils suggest parasites or allergy, but the cellularity is minimal. Cardiovascular disease can also be considered. It does not look like neoplasia or FIP. More cells may be beneficial.

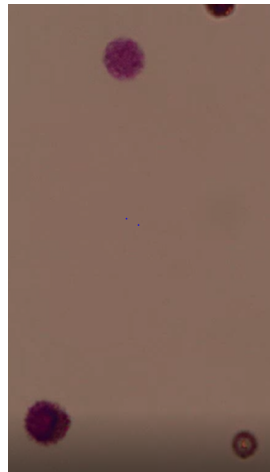


Image shows an eosinophil with RBCs and a possible lymphocyte. Note the very few cells.
