HOLTER MONITOR FINDINGS AND RHYTHM ASSESSMENT

Time analyzed	23:32h
Mean heart rate	82bpm
Maximum heart rate	240bpm

Interpretation: Underlying normal sinus rhythm with appropriate rate variation. A single VPC is seen, which is essentially a normal finding for a 24 hour recording.

Rhythm diagnosis: Normal sinus rhythm with a single VPC.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Essentially normal recording. No inappropriate bradycardia or tachycardia are noted, and no malignant arrhythmias identified. The HR is appropriate as compared to the diary, with normal rate and rhythm. Finally a single VPC is noted, which is considered incidental in an otherwise healthy dog. No issues are seen here.

If the arrhythmia is heard on exam in the future, an immediate spot check ECG is recommended. Suspicion is low in this case. Monitor for any syncope or acute onset lethargy as a sign of sustained issues.

No medications are indicated at this time.
