**SEX**

Male Neutered

Interpretation: Underlying normal sinus rhythm with apparently appropriate rate variation (no diary included). Three single VPCs are seen, which are essentially a normal finding for a 24 hour recording. No dysrhythmias observed.

**AGE**

5 years

Rhythm diagnosis: Normal sinus rhythm with rare isolated VPCs (3).

**WEIGHT**

40 lbs

**RECOMMENDATIONS**

Essentially normal recording. No significant extra-nodal tachycardias are noted, and no malignant arrhythmias identified. The HR is appropriate as compared to the time of day, although this cannot be confirmed without a diary. Finally, three single VPCs are noted, which is considered incidental in an otherwise healthy dog. No pathology is seen here.

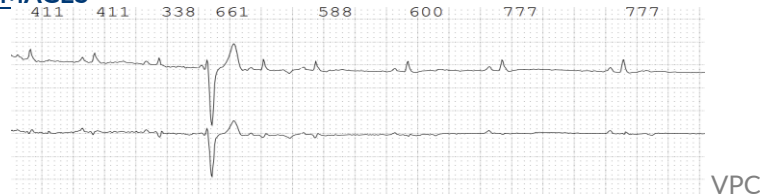

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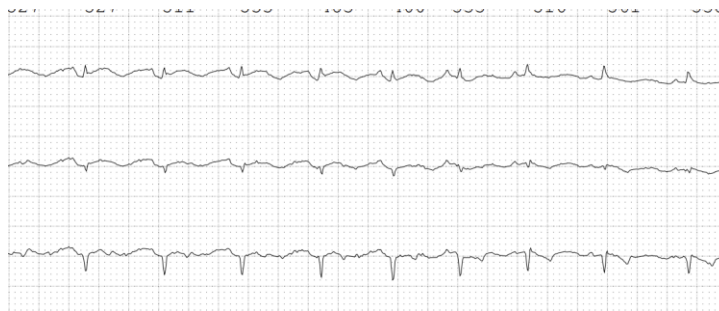
