OBSERVATIONS

Spleen: Submitted are 4 excellent videos of excellent collections of cells from the spleen in Smokey. The cellularity is mixed throughout the majority of these videos. The cellularity includes large numbers of neutrophils with scattered lymphoid cells, macrophages, rare plasma cells and many small mature lymphocytes. Malignant characteristics or mast cells or changes of sepsis cannot be identified.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Spleen - Chronic suppurative splenitis with a suggestion of lymphoid nodular hyperplasia but no suggestion of mast cell neoplasia.

SPECIES

Canine

COMMENTS

There are no changes in this collection to suggest mast cell neoplasia. There are changes that suggest inflammation and lymphoid nodular hyperplasia. These changes could be secondary to other problems in the abdominal cavity or nonspecific in this particular case. If problems continue, then treatment for inflammation may be beneficial but treatment for systemic mast cell neoplasia is not necessary in light of the observations in this collection from the spleen.

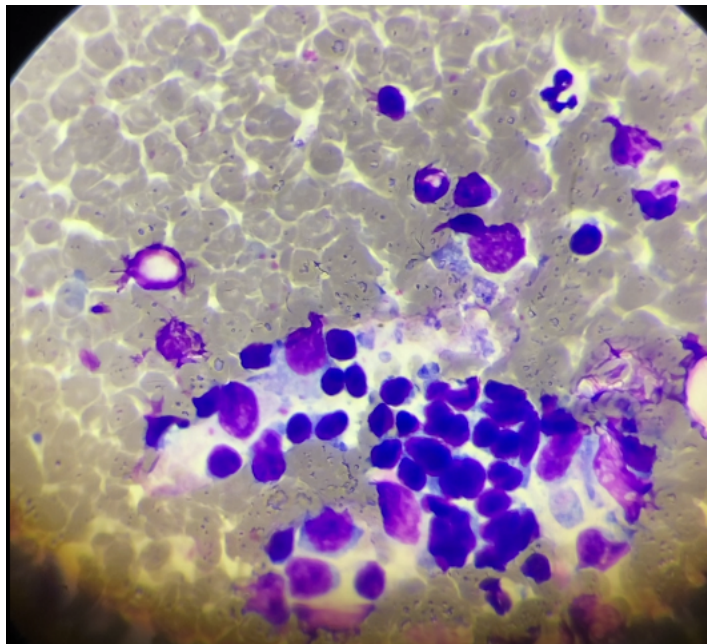
