HOLTER MONITOR FINDINGS AND RHYTHM ASSESSMENT

Time analyzed	23:47h
Mean heart rate	87bpm
Maximum heart rate	225bpm
Minimum heart rate	52bpm
VPCs	2 singles
APCs	0

Interpretation: Underlying normal sinus rhythm with appropriate rate variation. Max heart rate is during waking hours, and appears sinus in origin. Two single VPCs are considered normal and unremarkable. No significant pauses or dysrhythmias observed.
 Rhythm diagnosis: Sinus rhythm with rare VPCs. No pathologic arrhythmias seen.

RECOMMENDATIONS

No pathology is seen on this recording. Isolated VPCs are rare and considered normal. Reassess if any syncope/acute lethargy or arrhythmias are noted on exam. It is unclear the goal of repeat holters in this patient, without reported collapse, acute lethargy, etc. Follow is not indicated without associated clinical signs.

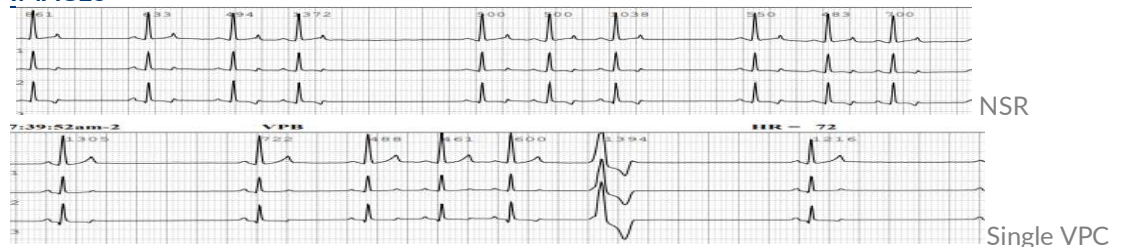

The serial echocardiograms have reportedly shown normal cardiac dimensions and function. There is no indication for Pimobendan, and this should be discontinued.

Consider consultation with an IM specialist if SHT appears refractory, as no vasodilator therapy is listed in the history.
