Interpretation: Underlying normal sinus rhythm with appropriate rate variation (limited diary available). Occasional single APCs noted. Occasional sinus pauses while sleeping appear normal. Rare VPCs; singles only.

AGE

4y

Rhythm diagnosis: Sinus rhythm with rare APCs/VPCs.

WEIGHT

98 lbs

RECOMMENDATIONS

Overall normal recording, with rare single APCs and VPCs. These are considered normal in dogs to this extent, and unlikely to cause clinical signs. While presumably sleeping, the patient does have evidence of high vagal tone and sinus pauses which is a normal finding. No additional issues are noted.

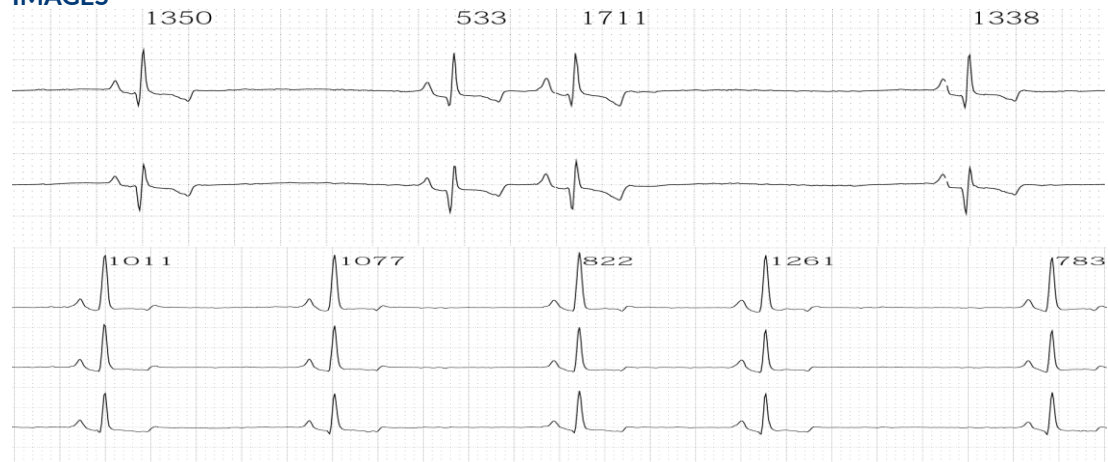

The cause of the episodes remains unknown as what is seen here is unlikely to cause issues. That being said, an episode did not occur with the monitor in place. Full systemic evaluation is suggested in a senior pet, with consideration of neurologic issues.

No treatment is indicated based upon what is seen here. Reassess based upon clinical progression.
