PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

History: Lethargy and occasional cough. Grade 4/6 murmur.
Sedated with dex/torb.

SPECIES

Canine

ELECTROCARDIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS *Note: Single lead ECGs are evaluated as a rhythm strip.
Morphology/MEA cannot be definitively commented on.

A single lead ECG is available from an AliveCor monitor; 50mm/s, 20mm/mV. The average heart rate is 100bpm (range 66-120bpm). The rhythm is sinus in origin, with a p for every QRS complex and vice versa. No ectopic beats, pauses or other dysrhythmias observed.
ECG diagnosis: Normal sinus rhythm with respiratory variation.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The submitted ECG is normal, with no evidence of dysrhythmias. The heart rate is relatively low; however, the patient is heavily sedated.
