PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

History: Unknown. Patient coming from BC. Owner notes that patient has a grade 2/6 murmur. Needs to be neutered. No medications.
 -Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Chemistry 10 normal.

ECHOCARDIOGRAM FINDINGS

2D, m-mode, color flow and doppler imaging is available. Minimal diffuse thickening of mitral valve leaflets with no obvious prolapse into the left atrial lumen. No mitral regurgitation is identified. Normal left atrial dimension. Normal LV diameter with adequate myocardial function. The tricuspid valve appears subjectively normal, with no tricuspid regurgitation. The right heart is normal (subjective). No overt evidence of pulmonary arterial hypertension. The pulmonic and aortic valves are normal in morphology and mobility. No aortic abnormalities identified, however the LVOT velocity is mildly elevated. Normal pulmonic outflow velocities. No aortic or pulmonic insufficiency. No pericardial or pleural effusion noted. No obvious congenital shunts.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

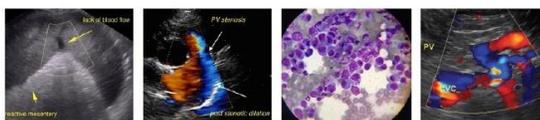
The only cause of a murmur identified is increased flow velocity through the LVOT/aortic root. No obvious subaortic ridge or valvular abnormalities are visualized, and in the absence of structural abnormalities this is considered a benign flow abnormality. It must be noted that this is not considered an extensive congenital study. Small abnormalities

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are easily missed and are not ruled out in this image set. Highly recommend referral to a local cardiologist for advanced echocardiography particularly should the murmur persist or progress in the future.

SPECIES

Canine

No cardiac medications are indicated. No cardiac contraindication for general anesthesia based upon what is seen here.

BREED

Jack Russell Terrier Mix

Monitor for any development of cough, labored breathing or exercise intolerance.

SEX

Male Intact

Plan: Highly recommend referral to a local cardiologist prior to anesthesia. If declined, recommend recheck echocardiogram in 12-18 months to reassess murmur origin.


