Lymph node: Submitted are 2 excellent videos of cells collected from the lymph node in Sam. The cells appear to be small lymphocytes with no additional cellularity. There are no characteristics of malignancy.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Lymph node - Reactive or stimulated lymph node tissue.

COMMENTS

The cellularity supports reactive lymphoid tissue. I cannot identify malignant characteristics. This may be draining from some reactive process. There are a few inflammatory cells. Continued evaluation for other problems is encouraged.

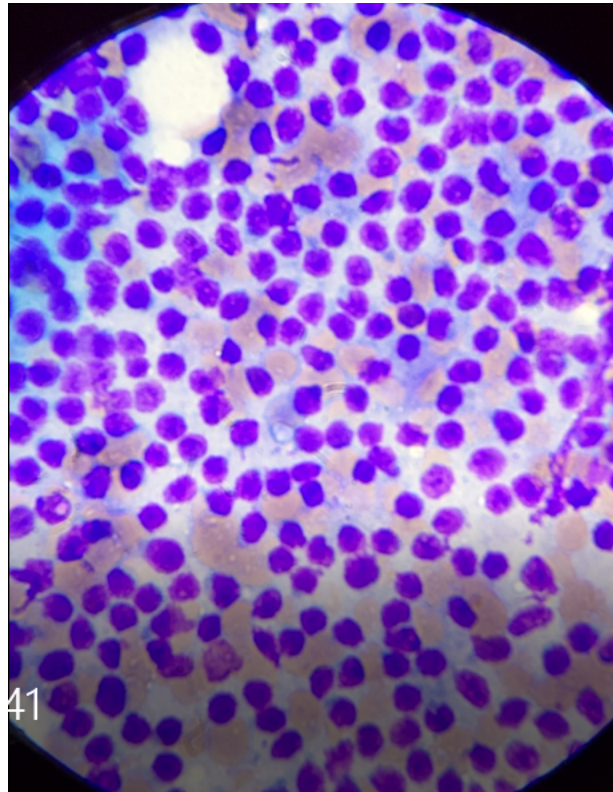


Image shows a representative collection of small lymphocytes from the lymph nodes in Sam. The nuclei are small.
