2D, M-mode, and Doppler study. This exam is compared to the one performed 1/26/21.

Left atrial size is normal. The mitral valve appears normal, though mild mitral regurgitation is present. Left ventricular wall thickness is normal. Left ventricular internal dimensions are normal. Left ventricular systolic function is hyperdynamic. The aorta and aortic valve are normal. Right atrial and right ventricular dimensions are normal. The tricuspid valve is normal. The pulmonary artery and pulmonic valve are normal. No shunting lesions are visualized. No pericardial effusion or cardiac masses are seen.

ASSESSMENT/RECOMMENDATIONS

SPECIES

Feline

This examination demonstrates mild regurgitation of blood across Bam Bam's mitral valve. The hemodynamic effects of the regurgitation also appear to be mild, as Bam Bam does not have secondary dilation of his left atrium, indicating that his current risk for the development of congestive heart failure or thromboembolic disease appears to be low.

BREED

No therapy is recommended based on this exam.

DSH

A recheck echocardiogram is recommended in 6-9 months, sooner if new clinical signs compatible with cardiac dysfunction develop.




