ECHOCARDIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

2D, M-mode, and Doppler study.

Left atrial size is normal. The mitral valve is normal. Left ventricular wall thickness is normal. Left ventricular internal dimensions are normal. Left ventricular systolic function is mildly hyperdynamic. The aorta and aortic valve are normal. Right atrial and right ventricular dimensions are normal. The tricuspid valve is normal. The pulmonary artery and pulmonic valve are normal. No shunting lesions are visualized. No pericardial effusion or cardiac masses are seen.

This examination demonstrates no evidence of structural heart disease. As such, no reason for Bandit's murmur or BNP elevation is appreciated in the image set. It's likely that Bandit's murmur is functional/innocent in nature, and it's possible that his BNP elevation could be a false positive.

BREED

No therapy is recommended based on this exam.

DSH

A recheck echocardiogram is recommended if the characteristics of Bandit's murmur change, or if other new physical exam and/or clinical abnormalities suggestive of cardiac dysfunction develop.
