PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

History: History of intermittent arrhythmia auscultated on physical exam but not present at time of ECG or echo (wnl; MML 8-2020). Patient was having occasional periods of lethargy and abnormal behavior ("seizure-like" episodes) during which owner reports feeling a very fast/irregular heartbeat. Otherwise healthy in between episodes. Holter 5/2021 showed AIVR with a brief salvo of VT. Sotalol recommended. Recheck holter.

Current medications: Sotalol 40mg BID

HOLTER MONITOR FINDINGS AND RHYTHM ASSESSMENT

Time analyzed	22:29h
Mean heart rate	57bpm
Maximum heart rate	147bpm
Minimum heart rate	33bpm
VPCs	9
APCs	0

Interpretation: Underlying normal sinus rhythm with appropriate rate variation. Dramatic improvement in ventricular arrhythmias; rare single VPCs persist. No AIVR; no VT.

Rhythm diagnosis: Sinus rhythm with rare VPCs. Improved on sotalol.

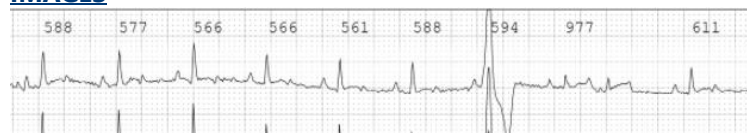
RECOMMENDATIONS

Dramatic improvement in ventricular arrhythmias which is great news. Occasional/rare single VPCs persist; however, this is considered good control. No change to the medication is indicated.

Even with significant improvement, patient will always be at risk for refractory/breakthrough arrhythmias and sudden death going forward. Monitor for any recurrent clinical signs.

Recommend a recheck ECG/holter in 6 months, sooner if any issues arise.
