PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

History: Abnormal episodes at home with heavy breathing/panting noted. CXR/echo/labs pending.
BP: 180, 175mmHg

SPECIES

Canine

ELECTROCARDIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

A brief three lead ECG is available; 25mm/s, 10mm/mV. The average heart rate is 80bpm (range 55-94bpm). The rhythm is sinus in origin, with a p for every QRS complex and vice versa. The P and QRS morphologies are positive. No ectopic beats, pauses or other dysrhythmias observed.
ECG diagnosis: Normal sinus rhythm with respiratory variation.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The submitted ECG is normal, with no evidence of dysrhythmias. The tracing is brief, and this does not entirely rule out intermittent arrhythmias as the cause of the episodes. If suspicion persists once further diagnostic results are available, a longer tracing (10 minute ideal) or potentially a holter monitor can be considered.
