



RESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

DATE History: New murmur. Asymptomatic.

9/20/21 **ECHOCARDIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**
2D, M-mode, and Doppler study.

PERFORMED BY: There is very mild left atrial dilation. The mitral valve appears normal, though trace mitral regurgitation is present. Left ventricular wall thickness is normal. Left ventricular internal dimensions are normal. Left ventricular systolic function is normal. The aorta and aortic valve are normal. Right atrial and right ventricular dimensions are normal. The tricuspid valve is normal.

INTERPRETED BY The pulmonary artery and pulmonic valve appear normal. No shunting lesions are visualized. No pericardial effusion or cardiac masses are seen.

ASSESSMENT/RECOMMENDATIONS

SPECIES This examination demonstrates very mild dilation of Stubbin's left atrium, with differentials for this finding including a restrictive cardiomyopathy (RCM), atrial myopathy, and cardiac thyrotoxicosis. As only very mild left atrial dilation is present, Stubbin's current risks for the development of congestive heart failure and/or thromboembolic disease appear to be low, though careful monitoring for progression dilation is recommended.

BREED A T4 level is recommended.

No therapy is recommended based on this exam.

SEX A recheck echocardiogram is recommended in 6 months to monitor for disease progression.
