OBSERVATIONS
Digital mass: Submitted are 5 excellent videos of moderate collections of cells from the digital mass along the pad on Nelson. The cellularity is mixed including neutrophils, lymphocytes, and scattered macrophages. There are scattered aggregates of cells that suggest macrophages and spindle cells. Characteristics of malignancy are not identified. The cellularity is most characteristic of chronic inflammation.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS
Digital mass - Pyogranulomatous inflammation with large numbers of lymphocytes.

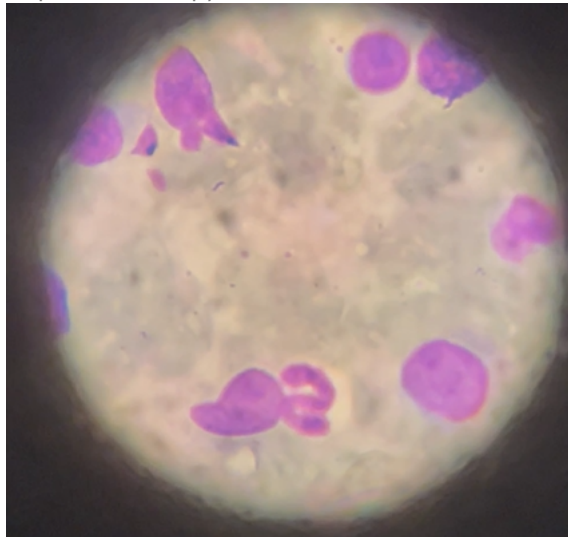
COMMENTS
The cellularity is most characteristic of an inflammatory process which is quite chronic in nature. The lymphocytes suggest chronicity and possible antigenicity from some type of infection or inflammatory agent. There are no changes that suggest sepsis or malignancy. Treatment with anti-inflammatory products or excision would be encouraged. A good prognosis is expected particularly if there is a good response to therapy.
