Findings

- At least two fetuses are suspected on today's sonogram. However, it can be difficult to determine the number of viable fetuses sonographically. At least one heartbeat is seen.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Consider abdominal radiographs to better assess for the number of fetuses present. However, fetal viability cannot be determined radiographically.
