History: 5-month-old intact female kitten presents for suspicion of pregnancy; intact male sphynx cat living in the home.

**LIMITED ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION**

At least 3-5 fetuses are observed within the uterus, although it is difficult to distinguish between fetuses. At least two separate heartbeats are noted in different fetuses.

**BREED**

Sphynx

Consider abdominal radiographs for a more accurate assessment of fetal number.
