PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Reason for the Holter: arrhythmia, 3rd degree heart block

HOLTER MONITOR STUDY

HOLTER MONITOR FINDINGS

These findings identify a normal sinus rhythm with no evidence of ectopy or conduction delay/block. There are rare sinus pauses with a junctional escape. This may represent an early manifestation of sinus node dysfunction, but in the absence of more prolonged pauses, or inappropriate runs of tachycardia, is not likely to be clinically significant at this time.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

In the absence of clinical signs (syncope), this rhythm is unlikely to be clinically significant. No cardiac therapy will be recommended. A repeat Holter monitor is recommended in 6-12 months to monitor for progression, or sooner if clinical signs develop.
