PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Reason for the Holter: severe sub-aortic stenosis
Medications: Atenolol 25mg: 1 tab PO BID long term.

HOLTER MONITOR FINDINGS

This study identifies an underlying normal sinus rhythm in the setting of very rare (1) premature ventricular complexes.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on these findings, no additional therapy will be recommended at this time. A repeat Holter monitor should be performed with another echocardiogram in 12 months.
