## PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

History: Progressively declined in appetite and weight over the past 2-3 months with left leg and wing weakness that has gotten worse. Has been tested for infectious diseases-all negative. Radiographs show possible liver or coelomic mass.

## ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION

The mid to cranial abdomen was imaged in this patient. The liver was uniform. There was no evidence of parenchymal pathology. The vascularity was normal. The stomach and gizzard had a minor amount of ingesta. The small intestine and colon were unremarkable. There was no evidence of masses or free fluid.

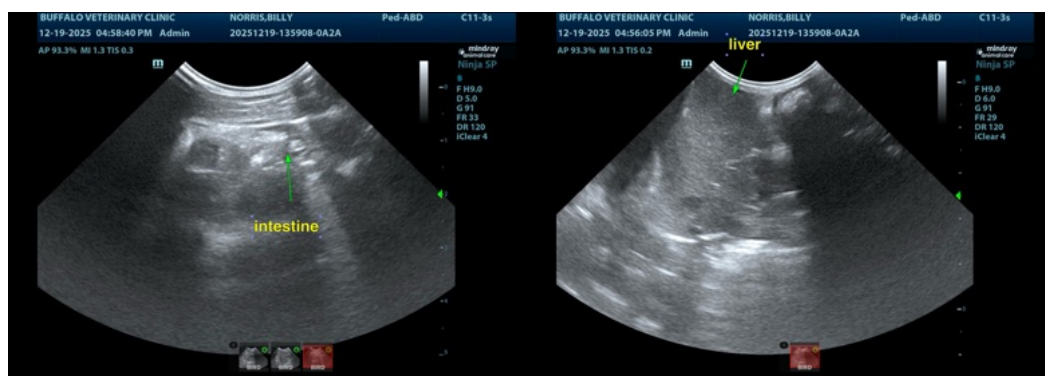
The heart was also imaged and presented normal contractility and volumes.

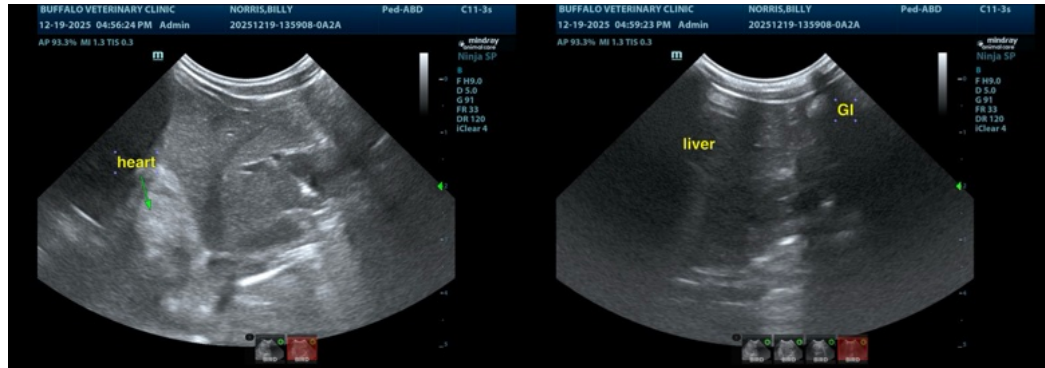
