History: re check u/s yesterday showed full stomach dog has been NPO since last night did eat dinner

LIMITED ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION

The **gastrointestinal tract** revealed a minor amount of retention of chyme with slight progressive shadowing. This is likely residual ingesta. Transit of chyme into the small intestine was noted. Slight soft foreign matter, such as grass or similar cannot be ruled out, yet this is not surgical.

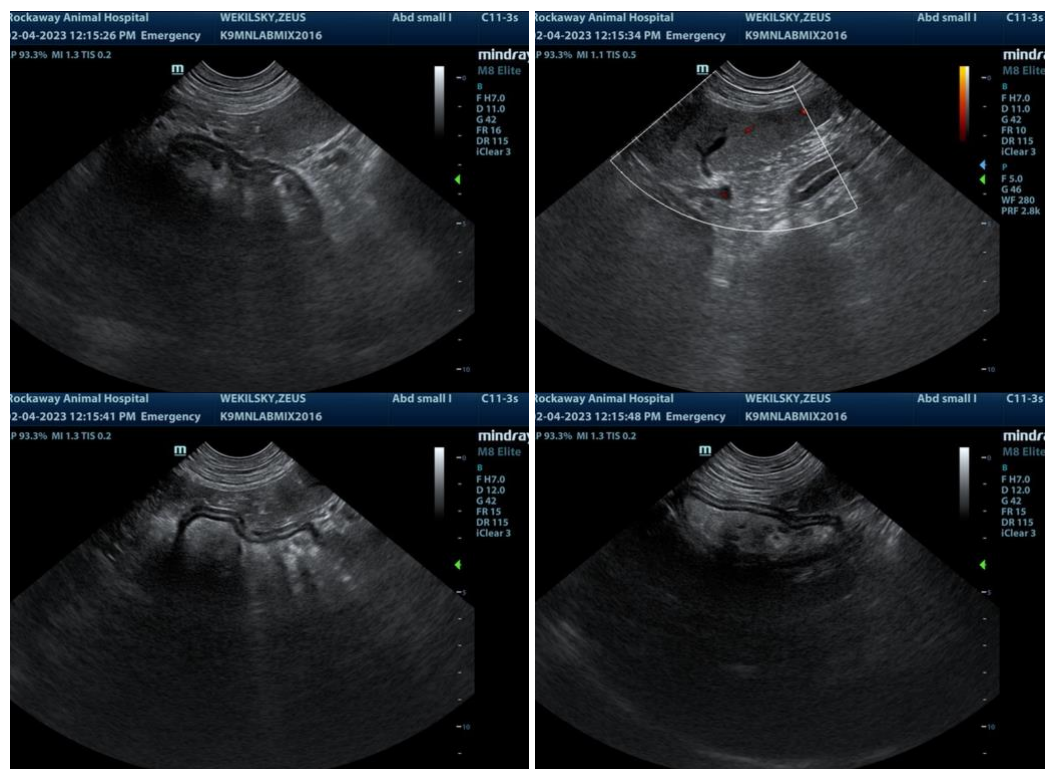
