PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Recheck prostate from 2 weeks ago. Symptoms resolved but owner is worried about re-occurrence.

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Mildly enlarged prostate for what I can feel.

RECHECK LIMITED ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION OF THE PROSTATE

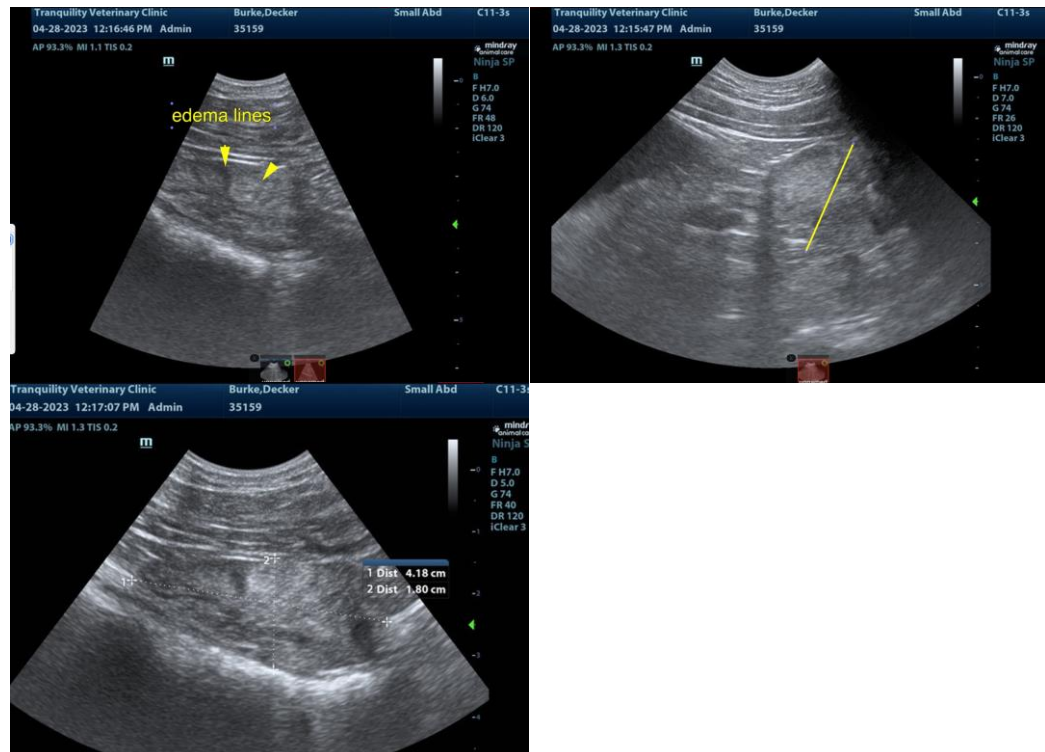
The prostate was mildly heterogenous with no evidence of active inflammation measuring 2.8 cm. Slight parenchymal striations were noted, possibly related to low grade prostatitis yet the changes are minor.

ULTRASONOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

- Minor prostatitis pattern without significant enlargement.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

If prostatic signs are persistent in this patient, neutering is indicated with urine C/S +/- prostatic wash.
