**PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

Diagnosed with sterile nodular panniculitis in March, started 80mg/d prednisone. Recently switched from pred to oral dex on a tapering dose starting at 4mg/d and tapering by 1 mg every week. Current dose 2mg/day. Also on Atopica 100mg BID since 5/12/22, and Doxycycline 300mg BID. Increasing liver values over the last month. Remission has not been achieved yet for the SNP. Bloodwork attached.

**LIMITED ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION**

The liver presented uniform parenchyma. The gallbladder and common bile duct were unremarkable. No evidence of masses.

**ULTRASONOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

- Non-specific inflammatory hepatopathy

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

FNA warranted for further definition. Leptospirosis titers indicated to rule out subclinical sise.
