**LIMITED ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION**

The **urinary bladder** revealed calculi and suspended debris.

The **kidneys** were mildly swollen. Slight amount of physiologic free fluid noted. The kidneys measured approximately 3.0 cm each with corticomedullary mineralization.

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

Given the young age and presence of bladder calculi, portosystemic shunting should be considered as a potential. Bile acid profile warranted, especially if microhepatica is present on radiographs.

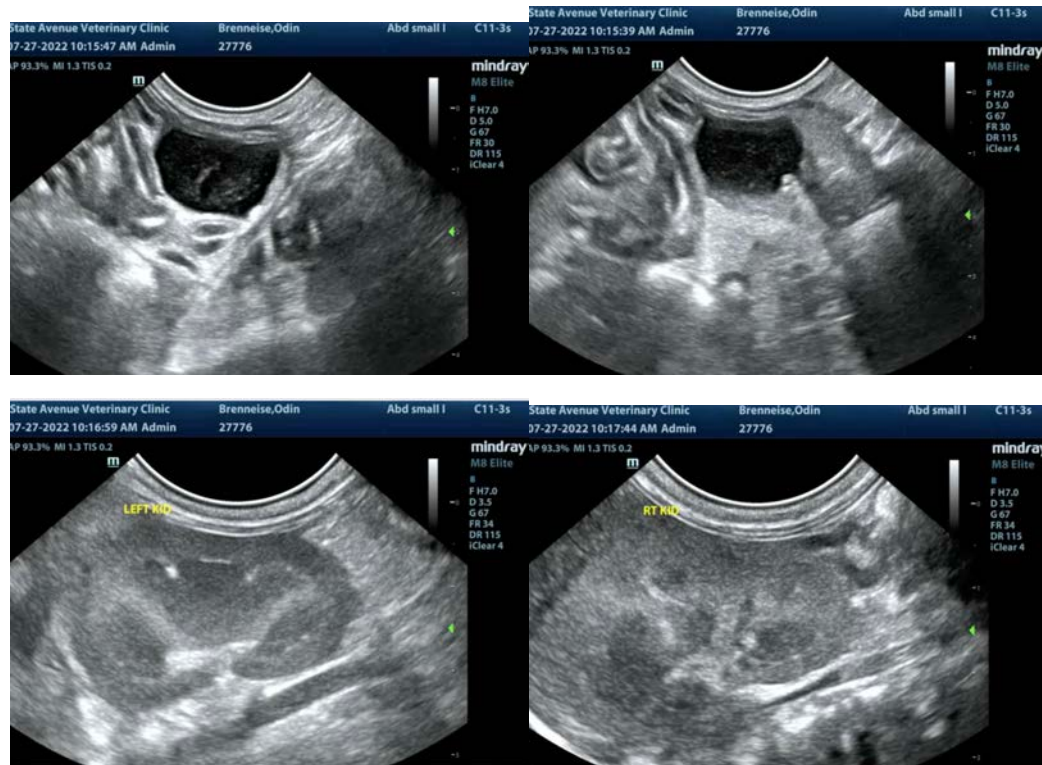
