



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Luna Teixeira Presented for second opinion, was at previous vet to check pregnancy August 9th (bred on June 28th). X rays and bloodwork done. PE: mildly distended tense abdomen- unable to palpate uterus. Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: BW shows elevation in white blood cells, neutrophils and monocytes No radiographically visible fetuses- Uterus enlarged- they discussed about suspect pyometra at previous vet

LIMITED ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION

Viable pregnancy was visualized. Fetal length crown of head to rump measured 6.1 cm. Active movement and subjectively normal fetal development present. Amniotic fluid was anechoic. 3 heartbeats were visualized. Fetal structure appears normal.

SEX

Intact Female

- Positive pregnancy, near term – subjective 3 viable fetuses, possibly more

AGE

1 Year

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Fetal count may be more accurate from radiographs. No evidence of infection or obvious congenital defects. Approximately 6-7 weeks gestation.
