**PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

History: recheck prev u/s 8/14 showed moderate variable to strongly shadowing gastric ingesta Dog did eat dinner last night

**ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION**

**Gastrointestinal**

The stomach in this patient revealed persistently shadowing material. Presuming the patient was n.p.o. this is most consistent with foreign matter combine with ingesta. There was some transit of chyme noted in the small intestine.

**ULTRASONOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

Full stomach with shadowing material and ingesta.

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

Given that the patient ate prior to the sonogram, I recommend 8-10 hour n.p.o. and reassessment as delayed outflow pattern and/or foreign matter is also possible.
