History: rechecking abd again from yesterday Dog has been truly NPO since 8/16 am

SPECIES ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION OF THE ABDOMEN

Canine

The stomach in this patient was empty other than anechoic fluid. However, significant echogenic mucosal remodeling was noted in the pyloric outflow with multi-focal, hyperechoic mucosal inclusions. This is consistent with ulcerative disease.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

AGE

3 years

There was no evidence of foreign body. There was no overt suspicion of neoplasia. I recommend GI protectant protocol and coverage for Helicobacter such as the following protocol over the next 10-14 days. A recheck echocardiogram is recommended in 10 days assuming the patient is doing well. B.i.d. canned feedings is recommended to avoid bulk issues. Delayed outflow may continue to be an issue. Pro motility medications may be appropriate such as Reglan if necessary. If clinical signs persist then gastroscopy is indicated.

Helicobacter/Gastritis protocol

A clinical trial of **Zithromax (Dogs: 5-10 mg/kg p.o. q24h. May increase dosing interval to q48h after 3-5 days of treatment)**, **Metronidazole (10-20 mg/kg p.o. b.i.d.)**, **Pepcid (0.5-1 mg/kg s.i.d.)** and **Sucralfate (0.5-2 g/dog PO) or Omeprazole (1 mg/kg p.o. s.i.d.)** over the next 3 weeks along with a **novel-protein or hydrolyzed diet** with slurry feeding b.i.d./t.i.d. over the next 2-4 days and then increase to canned diet bid. Dry food should be avoided over the next 4 weeks. A recheck sonogram to assess GI improvement or progression would be ideal in 4 weeks.

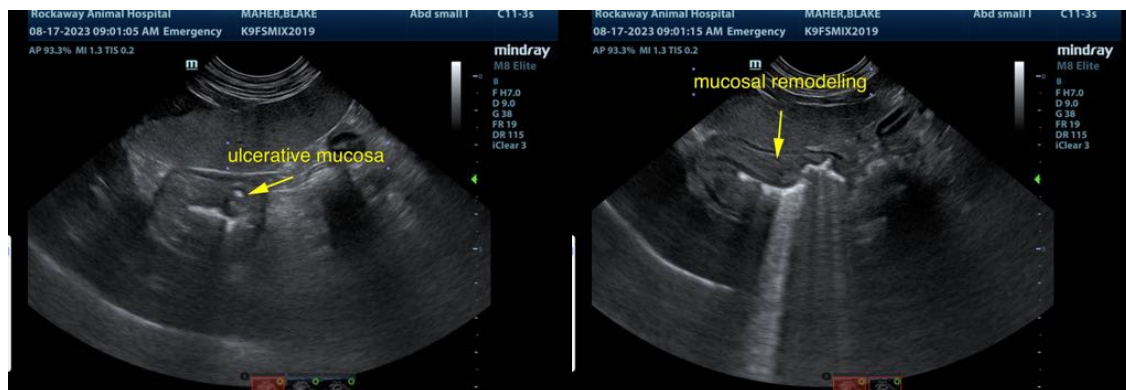
