History: Just need to look at adrenals

**SPECIES**

**ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION**

The left adrenal gland was subnormal in size and measured 0.3 cm in width. However, the right adrenal gland was enlarged, nodular and encapsulated measuring 2.5 x 1.8 cm cranial and 1.2 cm at the caudal pole. This is strongly suggestive for adrenal carcinoma. There was no evidence of vascular invasion.

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

**SEX**

Neutered male

Given the global presentation in this patient I recommend exploratory surgery, splenectomy and liver biopsy. Liver inspection and biopsy as well as right adrenalectomy is recommended. Serial blood pressure measurements are warranted to ensure systemic hypertension is not an issue.
