History: Slowly increasing hepatic values, no clinical signs  
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: ALT 230, no other BW abnormalities

The **liver** presented hypoechoic and mildly swollen with coalescing, ill-defined nodular changes. Slight increased portal markings were noted. The gallbladder and common bile duct were unremarkable.

**SEX**

Neutered male

**ULTRASONOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

Pronounced nodular hyperplasia liver pattern/inflammatory hepatopathy.

**AGE**

8 years

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

Core liver biopsy or ultrasound guided FNA is indicated. There is a potential for suppurative lesions or less likely metastatic disease especially given the lack of the clinical signs. Pronounced nodular hyperplasia and inflammatory hepatopathy is likely.
