Stanley Jackman History: Concerned about a potential mass in the thyroid Unable to palpate a concrete thyroid mass on PE PU/PD since P stopped prednisone on May 13th Elevated HR on PE today (05/18/22) T4 is >129 on BW meds: tramadol 100mg 1-2 q 8-12 hours

ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION

Thyroid

The left and right thyroid lobes and regional tissues were imaged. The esophagus, trachea and regional soft tissue were all normal. The thyroid glands lobes measured 0.5 cm each and were uniform. There was no evidence of masses or pathology.

Normal thyroid exam.
