Further imaging with concurrent manual rectal palpation was performed and the pelvic and sublumbal space with no evidence of pathology noted in this region. The spine, sublumbal and colonic spaces with all acoustic windows were imaged without pathology.

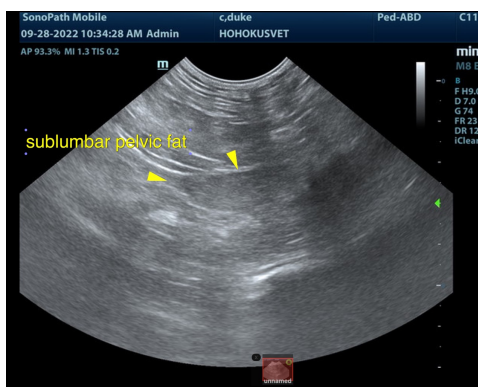
