## PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

This is a recheck scan of the Gallbladder 4 weeks after starting P on Ursodiol 62.5 mg PO BID

## LIMITED ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION

There is about 50% of the amount of debris in the gallbladder at this time compared to the prior exam on 2/20/26. This debris does appear mobile and freely moveable.

## INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

It does appear that the Ursodiol is helping to resolve the gallbladder mucocele. Recommend continuing Ursodiol for three more months, rechecking the gallbladder via ultrasound in three months, and recommend rechecking liver values in three months to determine if there is any evidence of significant cholestasis present.
