



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Fang Cello History: vomiting of 24 hours in duration, vomited 8x this am, mostly foamy frothy liquid. No diarrhea
Had a bowel movement yesterday

SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Canine The body condition score is 6/9 with smooth alternating layers of fat and soft tissue opacity.
The bony structures are within normal limits.

BREED The abdominal detail is good; diaphragm and abdominal wall are intact.

Shih Tzu X The liver is located within the costal arch and the caudo-ventral lobe is pointed.

The spleen appears physiological.

SEX

Neutered Male Stomach and cranial small intestine contain an ovoid structure of mineral opacity. Descending duodenum and one jejunal loop are air filled and mildly to moderately distended. Colon and rectum appear to be void of formed feces.

AGE

5 Years The left renal shadow has a physiological size, shape and opacity; the surfaces are smooth. The right kidney is obscured by intestinal loops. The bladder is located in the abdominal cavity and is empty, small calcified specks are located in its cranio-ventral aspect.

The sublumbar region appears physiological.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Localized ileus
- Foreign body small intestine and stomach
- Calcified structures in the urinary bladder (incidental finding)

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The localized ileus indicates an obstruction. It is possible that overhydration and pain killers may result in slow advancement of the foreign object through the small intestine, but its size makes it unlikely to pass the ileo-ceco-colic junction. I thus recommend surgery to retrieve both objects and palpate the entire small intestine to identify further objects. Urinalysis is necessary to identify the type of sediment in case treatment is required.
