Dior Figueroa History: Mammary tumor noted January 21', thorax met check

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

SPECIES The body condition score is 8/9 with smooth alternating layers of fat and soft tissue opacity. The bony structures appear physiological.

Canine

BREED

Yorkshire Terrier

The degree of pulmonary expansion is fair at best. The lungs are in contact with the thoracic boundaries and the tips are pointed. The lobar vessels are visible. Nodular opacities are not immediately obvious.

The cranial mediastinum is of physiological size and opacity. The trachea runs parallel to the thoracic vertebrae and dips at the carina.

SEX

Spayed Female

The cardiac silhouette occupies 85% of the chest height and 4 intercostal spaces (VHS 10). A small bulge appears to be present at 3 o'clock.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Small bulge level with left auricle

AGE INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

10 Years

A prominence of the left auricle can be associated with mitral valve insufficiency; thus, echocardiography is recommended. I can see no obvious metastases, but small nodules can be best appreciated with CT.
