PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

History: Chronic nasal congestion

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE HEAD

Mild ventral spondylosis is present on the caudal endplate of C2.

The bones appear physiological.

Nasal and ethmoid turbinates are evident, and they are surrounded by air. Both frontal sinuses contain air.

The right bulla wall is thickened and the opacity in the bulla lumen is increased.

Naso-, oro-, and laryngopharynx appear physiological.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

Right

- Otitis media, chronic

Incidental finding

- Spondylosis

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

I can see no changes that would explain the nasal congestion. However, otitis media can be associated with mucosal swelling and nasal discharge. Further examinations can include rhinoscopy and/or CT.
