



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Charley Gainer Patient presented for slipping out on back legs, owner states will also get shakey on legs as well. Painful on extension of hips. Crepitus in left stifle

SPECIES RADIOGRAPH OF PELVIS AND STIFLES

Canine 1x VD pelvis including stifles, R + L lateral hind legs, lateral spine, VD dogogram

BREED RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Terrier Mix All bones are well mineralized, have a normal trabecular structure and a smooth surface. Cortical-medullary development and differentiation of the long bones are physiological.

Pelvis

SEX
MN The centre of the left femoral head is superimposed over the dorsal acetabular edge, the centre of the right is located lateral to the dorsal acetabular edge. Both cranial acetabular edges are straight, but the hip joints appear to be congruent. No overt new bone formation is appreciated.

AGE
Stifles

15 Years Both stifle joints have smooth subchondral bone surfaces, and the centre of the femoral condyles is in line with the intercondylar eminence. The cranial fat pad has a physiological size, and the caudal fascial plains are in a physiological position. The cranial aspect of the meniscus is outlined by fat in both legs. New bone formation is not evident, and the patellae appear to be in a physiological position.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The absence of visible pathology immediately after the trauma does not preclude hairline fissures, which will be visible better after 10 days due to the osteoclastic activity. Damage to muscles or tendons can be imaged best with contrast CT or MRI. Alternatively, ultrasound can be used if one particular area causing the pain has been identified clinically.
