PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

History: LR digit #5 digital pad mass - present since around 09/2025. Did not respond to 7 days of clindamycin. Has been growing, more rapidly in the last couple weeks. Mass has ruptured. No purulent exudate. Flushing ruptured pocket under sedation revealed no exudate, debris, or foreign material.

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Punch biopsy result came back as lymphoplasmacytic dermatitis/inflammation but could not r/o neoplasia completely.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF LEFT HIND PAW

An egg-shaped soft tissue swelling with an undulating border is present on the plantar aspect of digit 5 with the punctum maximum located at P1/2. The otherwise homogeneous soft tissue opacity appears patchy on the plantar aspect and small mineralized areas are located inside.

All bones are well mineralized, have a normal trabecular structure and smooth, continuous surfaces. Cortical-medullary development and differentiation of the long bones are physiological.

All sesamoid bones are physiologically developed with smooth surfaces. The joints are congruent.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Digit 5: soft tissue mass

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The mass is rather large, and it is possible that pressure on the cortex may result in localized resorption. However, I feel that this has not yet happened. I suggest retaking the view that appears abnormal to you in 4-8 weeks to see if anything has changed.
