PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS History: P was having reverser sneezing and coughing the did not respond to the owner for 30 seconds (unconscious?) after then went back to herself right away. otherwise , everything is normal . no abnormal heart sound nor lung sounds are detected during physical exam. normal blood work including bnp and thyroid. p gained weight.

SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

SPECIES Canine
 The body condition score is 7/9 with smooth alternating layers of fat and soft tissue opacity.

The bony structures appear physiological.

BREED

BREED Yorkshire Terrier Mix
 The lungs are in contact with the thoracic boundaries and the tips are pointed. The lobar vessels are clearly visible to the tertiary branches. The bronchial tree is thin walled and tapers uniformly towards the periphery.

SEX

SEX The cranial mediastinum is of physiological size and opacity. The trachea runs parallel to the thoracic vertebrae and dips at the carina.

Female

The cardiac silhouette occupies 85% of the chest height and 3.5 intercostal spaces. No chamber or outflow tract enlargement is evident.

AGE

AGE The ventral liver lobe is pointed and located within the costal arch.

I can see no changes that would explain the clinical signs. However, pharyngeal, tracheal or bronchial collapse could be present and tracheoscopy is necessary to rule this out. Other causes for reverse sneezing include allergies, nasal foreign body, tonsillar enlargement as well as nasal inflammation or infection.
