



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Patches Moreau History: Was presented on 12th June for inappetence. No V/D/C/S. BAR, well hydrated, PE unremarkable. Rads done on 16th June. Currently on denamarin (liver supplement) & miratz. Abdominal US scheduled in 4 days.

SPECIES Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: ALP 238 (0-90) ALT 163 (0-100), creatinine 52 (71-159), rest BW unremarkable, fPL- WNL.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

BREED The body condition score is 7/9 with a soft tissue opacity of approx. 3cm lateral to the ribs.

DSH The bony structures are within normal limits.

SEX The abdominal detail is good; the ventral abdominal wall is tucked up. A large amount of fatty tissue appears to be present in the inguinal region on the lateral views.

Spayed Female The liver is located within the costal arch.

AGE The head of the spleen appears physiological.

13 Years The stomach contains air and some solid material; the small intestinal loops are located in the cranial abdomen and the desc. colon is stretched. Terminal colon and rectum contain gas.

INTERPRETED BY The left renal shadow appears rounder and smaller than the right. The bladder is located in the abdominal cavity and contains a small amount of homogeneous fluid opacity.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

REFERRING VET An asymmetry of the renal shadows per se does not imply a disease but in combination with the elevated creatinine renal disease is likely. I suggest treatment for early renal failure while awaiting the results of the abdominal ultrasound. Urine production should be monitored if possible. The accumulation of the small intestine in the cranial abdomen is likely due to the distribution of fat but could also represent adhesions due to inflammation.
