Uma Rizzo History: Acute Right hind lameness, medial buttress and toe-touching; Positive cranial drawer sign in both Right AND left stifles.

**SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE STIFLES**

Canine The cranial fat pad is reduced, and caudal fascial plains are caudally displaced. New bone formation is present on the cranial tibial plateau, as well as distal pole of the patella and fabellae. The centre of the right femoral condyle appears to be caudally displaced in relation to the intercondylar eminence of the tibia.

**BREED**

Rottweiler Irregularly shaped soft tissue nodules are located on the skin surface of the tuber calcis on both legs.
